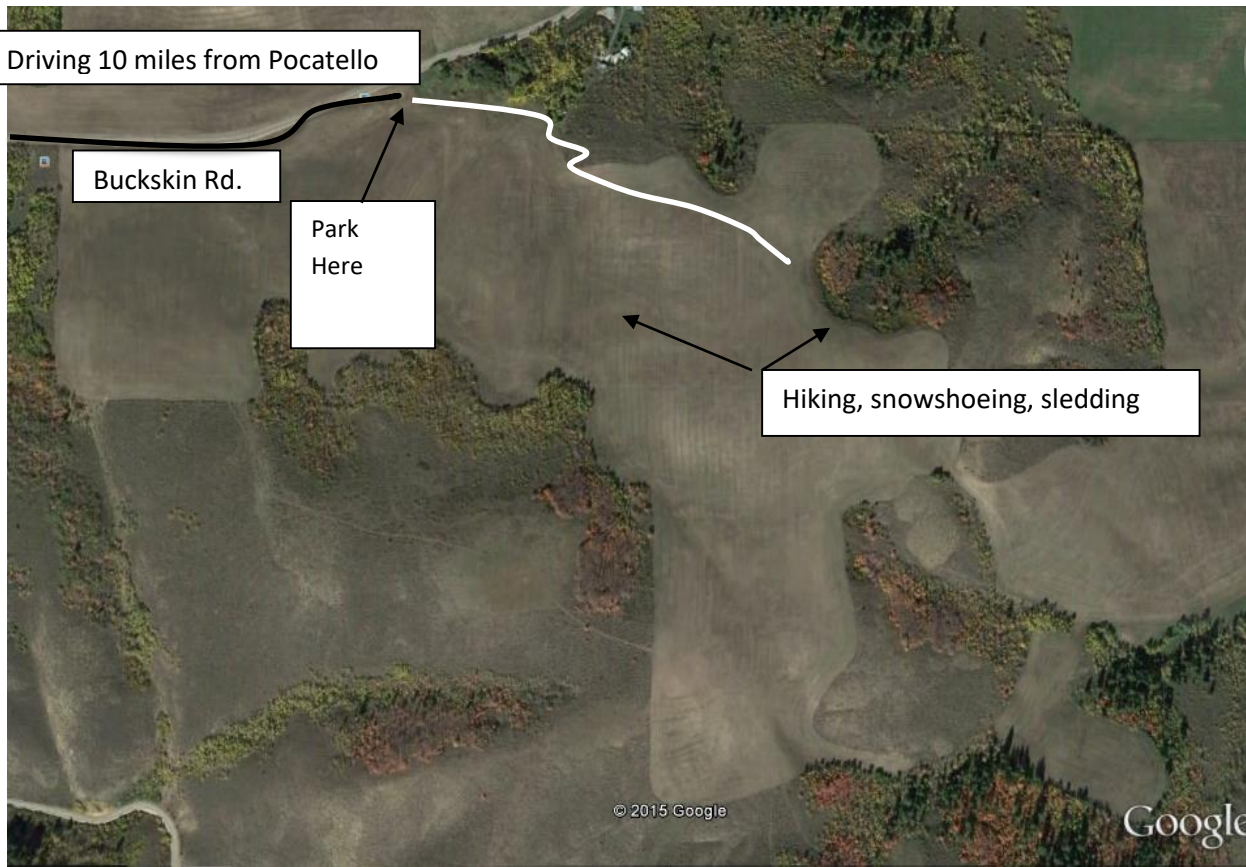

- Who:** All Tendoy Varsity Teams and Venture Crews and invited guests
- When:** **Friday & Saturday, February 24-25, 2017.** Arrival begins at 10 AM.
- Where:** **Parking** at 42° 52'12.40"N 112° 15'53.37"W OR 42.869916°, -112.264802° **Where the Klondike Derby was held.** Approximately 10.2 miles east of Pocatello Scout Service Center.

- What:** This **Winter Adventure** is the Districts way of welcoming the full winter camping experience with support from the District Leadership and other local units. All aspects of this Adventure are cranked “**UP A NOTCH**” to entice older more experienced campers to attend this exciting winter camp. Cold weather camping can be intimidating but we are here to help.

Innovative snow shelters are encouraged and will be part of the activities. Ask Ralph Oborn for ideas.
Remember BSA policy is that there are NO FLAMES IN TENTS.
Talk to us if you would like to go up a week or so early to create shelters
For extra fun bring your snow boards, toboggins, sleds, and snow shoes!
- Cost:** \$7.00 per person Youth and Adults.
- Schedule:** Arrive Friday after 10 AM, set up unit camps and snow shelters, create a great meal, and have fun.

- Food:** Participants will need to bring their own food for both days including an evening meal that is prepared by the boys that reflects a genuine effort to “impress” the judges for our Up a Notch cook off. Prepare something that is unique and delicious despite having to cook it outside in winter conditions.
Hot Chocolate will be provided throughout both days.

Directions from Pocatello Scout Office

- Drive east on Pocatello Creek Road. 1.5 miles
- Turn Right (South) onto Parks Road. 0.5 miles
- Turn Left (East) onto Buckskin Road. 8 miles of winding road. Don't turn onto Hoot Owl Road!
- Park vehicle in plowed parking area for District Klondike between Hoot Owl Rd. and Rapid Creek Rd.
- Please bring Cross Country Skis (Optional) or snowshoes and sleds for the sled run on Saturday.
- Check for last minute instructions a couple of days before event with the Pocatello Scout Office

Items to note:

- Team /Crew is responsible for food, water, snow transportation, shelter, fuel, and people. There is no running water at this camp area. Limited firewood can be found under the snow. Your team/crew will need to bring a way to melt snow for your water and cooking needs.
- Portable **restrooms** will be located near camping area.
- For Friday night, you will need to cook an "up a notch" meal that will be judged for great taste and creativity by the staff. Anything goes, as long as it is prepared by the boys and is cooked at the campsite.
- Please don't plan on bringing snow machines or ATV's.
