CAMPING INFORMATION GUIDE

This is a FAMILY FRIENDLY Event

- **Please no open use of alcohol. Illegal drugs are strictly prohibited.** Smoking is only approved in smoking areas or in your vehicle.
- **Please respect others space.** Quiet time starts at 10:00 PM and goes to 7:00 AM.
- **Remember the Boy Scout Values** – Trustworthy, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind
- **No Harassment or Hazing** - the Boy Scouts of America prohibit language or behavior that belittles or puts down other campers based on sex, age, race, religion, ethnicity, or for other differences. Unwelcome advances, racial slurs, chastisement for religious or other beliefs, or any other actions or comments that are derogatory of other people's differences.
- **NO** – Chainsaws, firearms, fireworks, loud music
Violation of this policy will result in the rejection of your group from camp with no refunds.

Camping Sites

- **Camping sites are SHARED sites booked to capacity.** This means that the campsite resources need to be shared with the groups who have booked the same site, including picnic tables, campfire benches, and campfire pits (if available) Campers can bring their own equipment (tables, elevated fire rings, etc.) if they wish. Tents or hammocks are approved camping gear. There is NO room for RV parking at camp sites.
- **Camping sites must be kept free and clean of litter by the campers!** There is garbage service at the main camp areas for dumping garbage.
- **CAMPFIRES are ONLY permitted in established or elevated campfire pits.** You may bring your own elevated fire pit. Charcoal can be used on elevated surfaces and in established rings. Propane is always appropriate.
- **Food should be prepared with bear and critter safety in mind** – All food and smell-ables need to be placed in bear boxes or vehicles away from camp sleeping areas when not in use. This includes pet food. Please secure your coolers as well in your vehicles and do NOT leave them permanently in your campsite.
- **Pets must be kept on a leash ALWAYS** – Or secured in your RV or tent.
- **Please ONLY use established latrines**
- **Parking in the Parking Lot** – PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY AND BE ALERT AND ATTENTIVE WHILE OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE ON SCOUT HOLLOW CUB CAMP PROPERTY. All passenger vehicles must remain parked in the parking lot.
- **Personal equipment should be secured** – The camp is not responsible for lost or damaged items left unattended at camp.

Campground Features

- **A trading post will be open** part of the time for some sundry items and snacks.
- **Program areas and equipment are off limits without staff approval**
- **The camp sits adjacent to the Snake River.** Please observe all Idaho fishing regulation. Enjoy the river at your own risk.



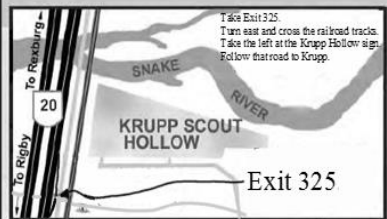
