**National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) and Kodiak Experience** are exciting, action-packed programs designed to provide youth with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. **Cedar Badge (CB)** is sponsored by the Grand Teton Council and provides an active environment for teaching youth cutting-edge leadership skills. The **Cedar Badge** course centers around the concepts of what a leaders must BE, what they must KNOW, and what they must DO. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on HOW TO. The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership. **Cedar Badge** is the best training available anywhere!

## **Boy Scout CB-NYLT** (12 and 13 year olds)



Boy Scout CB-NYLT uses the patrol method in a Scout Camp setting to teach leadership and Scoutcraft skills and help Scouts become effective leaders within the Boy Scout Program. Participants will experience:

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### **Qualifications to Attend Cedar Badge**

- Be registered with BSA (Boys and Girls)
- Be a First Class Scout (if attending Boy Scout or Varsity CB-NYLT, Boys only)
- Be age 14 by September 1 (if attending CB- Kodiak, Boys and Girls)
- Have week-long camping experience
- Be recommended by their unit or youth leader
