This adventure is for young men and women in fifth grade through high school. Troops are either all boy or all girl for their single gender learning environment. In Scouting, leadership is learned through experiences, both in the outdoors and in our communities. In Scouting, young people leadership and character in this time-tested program, youth lead their own activities and work their way toward earning Scouting’s highest rank, Eagle Scout.

Venturing



Venturing is a coed program for young adults ages 13, and have completed the 8th grade, through 20. Venturing focuses on adventure, leadership, personal growth, and service. Venturing crews are youth-led and adult advised. Crews can have a specialty interests, and youth can work in Venturing awards while also continuing to work towards Scouting’s highest rank, Eagle Scout.
