- Guidelines -

This is a 4-man scramble format tournament. Each player tees off. The team advances to the best shot. Each person on the team than shots from that best shot and so on until someone putts their ball into the hole.

- There is a brief opening at 8:00 a.m. This is a shotgun start. Play begins at 8:15
- The prizes for a Hole in One are correct. Each par three hole has a gift associated with a hole in one. No mulligans or licorice help is allowed – or course.
- For the Longest Drive – Please put your name on the sheet and mark your spot.
- Closest to the Hole, and Longest Putt sheet will be off the green so as to not interfere with future play. You will have to measure the distance with provided measuring tape and record on sheet with your name below the last person listed.
- Lunch will be at the club house after play (around 12:00ish)
- During lunch we will be presenting the awards for:
 - Best score.
 - Longest Drive for men and women.
 - Closest to the pin.
 - Longest putt (without any licorice help).

The use of Mulligans and Licorice rope

- Mulligans may be used throughout the tournament to give you a second try after a bad shot. To use a mulligan, you need to pay for a mulligan. Exceptions are that mulligans **cannot** be played on par three holes, longest yard tee offs, and putts.
- The licorice rope can be used to improve a lie but cannot be used on par three holes.
- You can purchase as many mulligans and licorice rope as you desire. They both cost \$20.00, or you can buy – 2 mulligans and 1 licorice rope for \$30.00.
